CODE OF CONDUCT

The purpose of the following standards of conduct is to ensure that the spirit of ESM Youth Sports, Inc. is maintained at all our events.

- Coaches shall remind players and supporters of ESM Youth Sports, Inc. goals. Coaches should be a model of good sportsmanship. They should neither encourage nor ignore unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Players shall display safe and sportsmanlike behavior at all times. Any act of unsportsmanlike conduct with intent to harm another player will result in immediate ejection from the game as determined by the official(s).
- 3. There will be cooperation with ESM Youth Sports, Inc. referees and officials. Any person who shouts disparaging or insultingremarks to an official, coach or player may be subject to ejection from the area.
